Community

Building community with one another is an essential part of living our faith, including:

- Support to help meet life's on-going challenges as well as in times of crisis;
- Engagement with one another that deepens our individual spiritual journeys and strengthens our lived values;
- Celebrations to mark significant events in the life of our community and to express our thankfulness for all that we have as well as to simply enjoy one another's company.

Outreach and Growth

The congregation will broaden the reach of Unitarian Universalism and spread its good news to

- Reach out to others in our community and welcome their participation in our midst;
- Welcome new members and friends into the life of our community in ways that affirm their journeys; and
- Deepen the meaning of membership for existing members.

Multigenerational

Our congregation will make multigenerational connections integral to the life of our community, especially:

- Regular opportunities to build community and expand a sense of "family" and familiarity across generations;
- Opportunities for meaningful participation for 'tweens, teens, young adults and our eldest elders to maintain connection; and
- An expectation that congregational life will be meaningful, fun and nurturing for people of all ages.

Multiculturalism

Our congregation will engage in authentic and meaningful expression of a variety of cultures and backgrounds, with

- Encouragement for people to express a variety of their identities in the activities of congregational life;
- Culturally respectful_efforts to explore a spectrum of cultures

- and learn from their wisdom sources; and
- Positive representation of a range of cultures, ethnicities and economic positions in the congregational practices and engagement.

Social change

Social change work will be an integral part of the congregation's identity of the congregation, with

- Justice-seeking activities that involve a significant percentage of the congregation;
- A core understanding of public ministry and interfaith efforts as being at the heart of our congregational life together; and
- Ever-deepening work on justice issues which build on the unique history of Unitarian Universalists and our congregation's history of working to better our world.
